



For Immediate Release: Hale Appointed to CCDC Board, Reberger Reappointed

BOISE— Capital City Development Corporation, Boise’s redevelopment agency, today announces the appointment of John Hale to the CCDC Board of Commissioners. Hale was appointed by Mayor Dave Bieter and confirmed by the Boise City Council at the regular meeting yesterday. He will complete the remainder of the term of Commissioner Dale Krick, who had resigned from the board after serving since 1999. The City Council also confirmed Commissioner Phil Reberger to a new term. The nine-member CCDC board is appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the council for five-year uncompensated terms.

John Hale is the managing partner of KPMG LLP Boise. He provides advisory services to clients on credit risk, financial risk, mergers and acquisitions, financial management and regulatory matters. His clients have included Albertsons, Washington Mutual, Wells Fargo, Deutschemark, Cap One, Goldman Sachs, Google, DaimlerChrysler and the International Monetary Fund. For two years, John managed KPMG’s advisory practice in Latin America, a seventeen-country practice headquartered in Mexico City. Prior to rejoining KPMG in Boise, Hale served as the chief risk officer for Provident Financial Services, a large retail bank in San Francisco.

Hale has served on the boards of the Boise Metro Chamber of Commerce, the Boise Valley Economic Partnership, Ballet Idaho, the University of Idaho Accounting Department Advisory Board and the Idaho Non Profit Center. He has also served on the YMCA Finance Committee, the Idaho Film Industry Task Force and the Boise Infill Task Force. Hale earned B.A. and M.B.A. degrees from the University of Idaho.

Phil Reberger has served on the CCDC board since 2003. He is a partner in the governmental affairs firm Sullivan&Reberger. In 2003 he retired as former Idaho Governor Dirk Kempthorne’s longtime chief of staff, a position he held since 1992. In over four decades of public service, Reberger served on the staffs of two governors, four United States senators and the Republican

National Committee. He currently serves on the Idaho Judicial Council, the Idaho State Building Authority, the Idaho YMCA Youth Government State Committee, the Arid Club Board of Directors and the USS BOISE (SSN 764) Sponsorship Committee. Reberger is a United States Navy captain and Vietnam veteran, having served on active duty as staff pilot to Admiral John McCain, Commander in Chief Pacific. He retired in 2002 as chief of staff to the Commander, Navy Reserve Security Group. A Caldwell native, Reberger earned a bachelor's in business from the University of Idaho.
