

Brownfield Assessment Grant OPEN HOUSE

Capital City Development Corporation, in partnership with the City of Boise and Idaho Department of Environmental Quality, is applying for a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency to assess potential brownfield sites in the 30th Street Area (AKA the West End).

Come to the open house and learn about:

- The proposed brownfield grant application
- How the brownfield assessment process can help promote redevelopment
- Examples of previous brownfield assessment and remediation efforts in downtown Boise

If awarded, the grant will help to inventory, characterize, assess, direct planning (including cleanup planning) and community involvement related to brownfield sites within the 30th Street Area. By reducing the uncertainty in brownfield redevelopment, this effort will promote development of brownfield sites and other underutilized land thereby leading to improved neighborhood health, welfare, and vitality.
